Mathematics Y5/6 “Describing properties of shapes – how would you describe the properties of a person?”

Mathematics Y2 Wonder/ humility “ What is the biggest value number in our number system?”

Art Y5 “Wisdom – wise words of William Morris used to support pupils’ printing projects”

History Y3/4 “ Compassion – discussing the issue of slavery in Roman times – seeing all viewpoints – who was the real friend?”

PE Y6 Friendship through peer to peer sports coaching

YR/1 Friendship – fetching a friend’s coat before playtime
